A Hunter Education Certificate is mandatory for first-time hunters, and youth ages 12-15. This course will teach hunting safety, principles of conservation, and sportsmanship, in a safe and fun atmosphere. Upon successful completion of the exam, your child will receive a Hunter Education Certificate.

The class will be held in **Richmond on Saturday, August 23, 2008, from 9:30 am until 4:30 pm, and on Sunday, August 24, 2008, from 9:30 am until 1:00 pm.** Attendance both days is required, and lunch and drinks will be provided on Saturday and Sunday.

Space is limited to 25 participants. There is no minimum age, but your child must be able to read and comprehend the materials provided. Pre-registration is required. To register your child(ren), please contact:

After the class concludes on Sunday at 1 pm, we invite your child to practice the skills they've just learned with a round of sporting clays! Eye and ear protection, and adult supervision, are required to participate in the live fire portion of this event. We'll have shotguns and shells available, or your child may bring their own gun (shotguns only).



The class will be held outdoors, rain or shine, at 6061 River Road, Richmond, VA 23226, located on the banks of the James River near the University of Richmond and the north end of the Huguenot Bridge. From I64, take the Powhite Parkway south to the Cary Street Road/Grove Avenue exit. Turn right onto Cary Street Road. At the stoplight at River Road Shopping Center (the intersection of Huguenot Road & River Road, just before the Huguenot Bridge), turn left onto the single lane private road between two brick buildings (look for mailboxes, located directly to your left at the stoplight).
